Enrichment, Fun & Support

The program strives to contribute to the social-emotional, physical, and intellectual growth of children in a safe, supportive learning environment. The WMCC Afterschool Youth Club provides enrichment, fun and support in a caring, supervised environment with opportunities to complete homework, get tutoring assistance, build social skills, utilize computer access, and to learn from our adult and youth leaders. The average adult to child ratio is 1:12. Staff credentials vary with a mix of college degrees, experience with school-age children and activity specialization. Additional activities will be provided to all of the youth on a daily basis. Programming will reflect both activities that are planned by the adult staff and those ideas the kids generate themselves and will include (but not be limited to) sports and physical activities, STEM, arts and crafts and computer games.

Hours and Days of Operation: The Afterschool Youth Club is available 2pm-6pm Mon., Tues., Wed., Thurs., and Fri. There are 3 Early Closure days in the year when the program closes at 4PM: the Wednesday before the Thanksgiving break, the day before the Winter break, and the last day of school.

Programming: Activities include arts and crafts, sports, science, drama, music, dance, cooperative games, literacy, community service, indoor and outdoor free play, and more!

Schedule: WMCC Afterschool Youth Club operates according to the regular Medford Public Schools schedule. The first day of AYC will begin on 8/30/23. The program is closed for holidays and school vacation weeks. Programming begins at the end of the scheduled school day and continues until 6:00pm. The After School Program does not operate if the schools are closed.

Program Registration & Fees: Both new and returning families are responsible for a yearly non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per family. If the student withdraws from the program prior to the start of the new school year or at any time during the school year, the registration fee is non-refundable. Attendance and pricing options are as follows: \$500.00 per month for 5 days a week; \$300.00 per month for 3 days a week; \$200.00 per month for 2 days a week.
